

# 100<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion Legacy Organization and Frances Okazaki Memorial Scholarships

2018-2019 Information Sheet

Perpetuating the Legacy of the 100<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion WWII (Separate)

*These scholarships will be awarded to deserving students, who are recognized not only for excellence in academics and community service, but also for their pursuit in promoting the legacy of the 100<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion (Separate) so that others will value freedom, loyalty, patriotism and trust. One Legacy Organization award will be for \$3,000 and one award will be for \$1,000 in honor of Mr. Kazuo Yamane. The Okazaki Memorial Scholarship was endowed by a woman whose plans for a mainland college education were ended by the start of World War II.*

## **Qualifications:**

To qualify an applicant must be a graduating, high school senior from the state of Hawaii who will attend an institution of higher learning in the Fall of 2019.

Applicants of the 100th Infantry Battalion Memorial Scholarship may apply. If a student receives a scholarship from the 100<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion Memorial Scholarship he/she will not be eligible for the 100<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion Legacy Organization Scholarships. Past recipients of scholarships from the 100<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion Veteran's Organization or the 100<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion Legacy Organization are **ineligible**. Questions of eligibility should be directed to Attention IBLO Scholarship committee via e-mail.

## **Instructions:**

1. Submit your signed application form to the address above. Must **be received by March 22, 2019**
2. Submit an official high school transcript.
3. Submit two letters of recommendation. One letter must be from a teacher. The other letter must come from a community leader such as a non-profit agency supervisor, an employer, or a volunteer supervisor, etc.
4. Type or print the requested information in black ink.
5. Do not attach or include anything that is not requested such as a photo or non-related essays or materials.
6. Do not submit items which you want returned. All application materials are confidential and nothing will be returned.
7. If the student plans to attend a mainland school, they must indicate their interest in being considered for the Okazaki Scholarship on the application form.
