Plagiarism will automatically disqualify an entry.)</p> <p>Research the significant cultural, economic, political, social and intellectual events that occurred between 1920-1950 and consider the impact these events had on the lives of the Nisei Veterans, their values of family, community and service. Write an argumentative essay that shows/ represents your own thinking/ thesis. You should support your ideas by facts, statistics, expert or Veteran testimony and examples. In addition, address the question: Is the Legacy of the World War II Nisei Veteran worth perpetuating? Why? Why Not? Include specific recommendations. Include the difference between the 100th Infantry Battalion and the 442 Regimental Combat Team</p>
