Plagiarism will automatically disqualify an entry.)</p> <p>The medics of the 100th Infantry Battalion (Separate) had a vital role in the battalion's historic achievements during World War II in Italy and France. Explain who they were, how they were organized and why they were often called “unsung heroes.” Cover the five Ws (who, what, where, when , why) . Discuss immediate and long-term impacts the medics had on the battalion, using specific examples. Describe if the accomplishments of the medics have made an immediate or possibly long term impact on you personally.</p>
