2013 Information Sheet

Memorializing the Medics, Unsung Heroes of the Battlefields

This scholarship will be awarded to a deserving student, who is recognized not only for excellence in academics and community service, but also for his/her pursuit in promoting the legacy of the 100th Infantry Battalion (Separate) so that others will value freedom, loyalty, patriotism and trust. The award will be \$3,000.

Qualifications:

To qualify for this scholarship an applicant must be a graduating, high school senior from the state of Hawaii who will attend an institution of higher learning in the Fall of 2013.

Applicants of the 100th Infantry Battalion Memorial Scholarship may apply. However, only one award will be made per student. Past recipients of scholarships from the 100th Infantry Battalion Veteran's Organization or the 100th Infantry Battalion Legacy Organization are **ineligible**. Instructions:

1. Submit your signed application form by **March 4, 2013**.
2. Submit an official high school transcript.
3. Submit two letters of recommendation. One letter must be from a teacher. The other letter must come from a community leader such as a non-profit agency supervisor, an employer, or a volunteer supervisor, etc.
4. Type or print the requested information in blue or black ink.
5. Do not attach or include anything that is not requested such as a photo or non-related essays or materials.
6. Do not submit items which you want returned. All application materials are confidential and nothing will be returned.
